PURPOSE

This Scholarship Program is designed to:

1. Promote interest in the construction industry by assisting S.C. Residents to achieve a higher level of education in the industry or a field directly related to it.

GENERAL POLICIES

- 1. The scholarship program shall be supported entirely through voluntary contributions and/or funds raised by the members of the Columbia Chapter #113., and administered by the Scholarship Committee and the Chapter Board of Directors.
- 2. The Scholarship Program shall be promoted by Columbia, SC Chapter #113 members at the High School and College levels.
- 3. The recipients shall be selected from applicants obtained through the high schools, colleges, universities, or technical/trade schools in <u>South Carolina</u>. The recipient must attend a college, university or technical/trade school in South Carolina. Each applicant must submit a <u>fully</u> completed application as furnished by the Chapter, copy attached. Final selections shall be made by the Scholarship Committee. An Incomplete application will invalidate it. Copy of scholarship application with pertinent guidelines for completion can be found on the Chapter website: <u>www.nawiccolumbia.org</u>
- 4. The application may be made by hard copy to NAWIC, Attn. Scholarship Chair, Post Office Box 7531, Columbia, SC 29202-7531 OR sent via e-mail directly to the Scholarship Chair. (See page 5 for contact information.)
- 5. The scholarship recipient, ONCE APPROVED, shall be notified in writing with appropriate details of his/her scholarship. All scholarship applications will be acknowledged. .
- 6. The amount of each scholarship shall be determined by the Scholarship Committee by available funds, with a minimum of \$500.00 award. The check will be made payable to the scholarship recipient.
- 7. The scholarship shall be continued <u>provided</u> the student maintains at least an overall 2.850 GPA average in all subjects taken with primary emphasis on the construction subjects. It is <u>imperative</u> that a scholarship recipient provide the proper information as required immediately upon completion of a semester, including grades, written letter of request to continue on scholarship (prior to beginning of each semester), and a copy of their class schedule for the following semester, or the student <u>will not</u> be considered for the following semester.
- 8. Should the recipient transfer to a field <u>not</u> related to the scholarship guidelines, the scholarship shall be discontinued. The same applies to a recipient who drops/withdraws any construction related courses unless extenuating circumstances are explained in writing to the Scholarship Committee.

9. The deadline for new application shall be June 1 for the Fall semester and December 1 for the Spring semester.

NOTE: It is permissible when completing the application, if your parents are still living under the same roof and not divorced, etc. to state "SEE ABOVE" when completing section 6 of the application (under Mother) on address and telephone number blanks.

ELIGIBILITY

An applicant for this scholarship shall be:

- 1. A resident of South Carolina.
- 2. Pursuing a course of study at an institute of higher learning in South Carolina and the course must be directly related to the construction industry (i.e. Architectural, Electrical, Mechanical or Civil Engineering, Drafting, Interior Design, Surveying, Project Management, etc.)
